Supplier Sustainability Code of Conduct

As a major player in the cosmetic industry, MINASOLVE Personal Care is committed to a Corporate Social Responsibility approach. As a signatory of "Responsible Care®", we also want our suppliers and subcontractors (hereinafter the "Suppliers") to commit to this approach in four areas:

1. Respect for human rights at work

 - o Treat and reduce emissions into the air and aqueous waste,
 - o Prevent all forms of pollution, including accidental pollution,
 - o Reduce energy consumption,
 - o Prevent industrial risks by implementing process safety management

3. Health and safety

We ask our Suppliers to ensure a working environment that is conducive to the preservation of the health and safety of their employees. To this end, our Suppliers undertake to:

- Comply with local and national health and safety regulations,
- Have a health and safety management system,
- Provide appropriate training for employees,
- Have an operational and regularly tested emergency management system.

4. Ethics

We require our Suppliers to operate in an ethical manner. To this end, our Suppliers commit to:

- Comply with all applicable local and national laws,
- Not tolerate bribery or extortion,
- Operate in a spirit of fair competition and avoid conflicts of interest,
- Protect intellectual property by not disclosing confidential information.

We hereby confirm that:

- We have received and fully understood the MINASOLVE Supplier Sustainability Code of Conduct.
- We are committed to the implementation of these principles and that failure to do so may be considered a breach of our obligations.
- We are committed to extending these principles to our own suppliers and subcontractors and will encourage them to follow them.
- We give you the opportunity to come and check the implementation.
